Pulp Clamp - There is a variety of lift truck attachments obtainable to be able to make the equipment much more useful. A snowplow attachment could be mounted to the front of the lift truck. A scoop bucket could be helpful if the job requires moving gravel, snow, sand, or soil. A double block handler allows the individual operating the forklift to pick up two loads and after that stack them side-by-side. Many of those accessories are really ideal for light to medium duty work.

Among the lift truck attachments, referred to as a package lift clamp, allows for the transferring and carrying of heavier pallets. Pallet crane forks are also utilized in order to move and carry pallets by using an overhead crane. A drum clamp attachment is useful for moving very heavy drums from one place to another without having to use a pallet. Forklift mounted hoppers enable material to be transferred and dumped with out having to do it manually. These hoppers when the bumper is released are self dumping.

Accessible attachments now consist of attachments which enable a lift truck to perform the task of a commercial broom or mop. Such specific accessories are often used cleaning parking lots, storehouse floors, and boat docks. Lift truck mounted platforms are accessible outfitted with dual entry doors and can be attached so as to transport workers from one area to another. The mounted platform attachment is nice for reaching areas which are difficult to access, specifically if you have products or supplies stored in out of the way locations or really up high.

Attachments could be a very helpful piece of equipment when put in a forklift, changing an typical forklift into a mobile crane unit. It is most helpful when maneuvering unbalanced or difficult loads. This accessory could either be mounted on the carriage itself, telescopic, or be connected or even forklift mounted.
